## This is not a typical swim trip — and it is certainly not a standard boat.





# The Journey

From Roman amphitheatres to medieval bell towers, rugged island wilderness to the historic stone streets of Šibenik, this seven-night liveaboard swim journey traces one of Croatia's most beautiful and diverse coastlines. We move slowly south, island by island, anchoring in quiet bays, national parks, and tiny archipelagos where the water is impossibly clear and the pace of life naturally softens.

Each day unfolds around the sea — circumnavigating the calm bays of the Brijuni islands, the protected channels of Losinj, swimming in the sandy shallows on Rab, taking in the dramatic limestone cliffs & secret coves in the Kornati, & the sheltered turquoise bays in Telaščica. By the time we reach Šibenik, the landscape has shifted, the rhythm has settled, and the group has truly found its flow.



# Swimming At Your Level

This trip is designed so **everyone belongs in the water.**

For those newer to open water, there are daily opportunities to float, bob, and swim safely beside the boat in calm, sheltered bays. For more experienced swimmers, each location offers the chance to step a little further depending on the desire of the group — with carefully chosen swims ranging from 1 to 4 kilometres, including island circumnavigations, coastal loops, and point-to-point routes between coves.

Swims are always optional, never forced, and supported by safety boats, clear briefings, and thoughtful planning. Whether you're building confidence or seeking adventure, the water meets you where you are.

## Pula

A striking blend of ancient history and Adriatic ease. Roman amphitheatres rise above the sea, narrow stone streets hum with café life, and the harbour glows at sunset. Pula is both grand and grounded — the perfect place to gather, exhale, and take your first swim in luminous Croatian waters.

## Brijuni Islands

An archipelago of quiet elegance and protected beauty. Crystal-clear shallows, pine-scented air, and peaceful anchorages create a feeling of stepping into a private world. The water here is impossibly transparent — perfect for relaxed, unhurried swims in serene surroundings.



## Cres

Wild, rugged, and beautifully untouched. Cres offers dramatic limestone cliffs, secluded bays, and an authentic island atmosphere. Swimming here feels expansive and elemental — long stretches of glassy water framed by raw natural beauty.

## Mali Lošinj

Colourful façades line the harbour and pine forests tumble into calm, protected channels. Known for its healing climate and maritime heritage, Mali Lošinj combines lively charm with wonderfully sheltered swim routes that feel both safe and spectacular.

## Silba

Car-free and quietly enchanting, Silba moves at its own gentle rhythm. Sandy paths, turquoise shallows, and intimate coves create a dreamy backdrop for relaxed swims and peaceful exploration.

## Pag

Moonlike landscapes meet striking blue sea. Pag's dramatic, sculpted coastline offers bold contrasts and wide horizons, while its historic town centres provide charm, local cheese, and vibrant Dalmatian energy.



## Rab

Golden sands and warm, shallow waters soften the Adriatic's edge. Rab's iconic skyline of bell towers rises above terracotta roofs, creating one of Croatia's most picturesque settings — inviting for playful swims and evening wanders alike.

## Zadar

Where ancient Roman ruins meet modern artistry. Swim in crystalline water by day, then watch the sun sink to the sound of the Sea Organ at dusk — an unforgettable blend of culture, history, and coastal beauty.



## Sali

Authentic, understated, and deeply local. Sali on Dugi Otok offers dramatic cliffs, expansive horizons, and a slower island pace — ideal for immersive swims in deep sapphire waters.

## Sakarun

Often described as one of Croatia's most beautiful beaches. Powder-white sand and luminous turquoise shallows create almost tropical conditions — calm, clear, and utterly inviting.



## Veli Rat

Home to one of the Adriatic's tallest lighthouses, Veli Rat combines open horizons with pristine waters and dramatic coastal scenery. A striking, spacious setting that makes every swim feel cinematic.

## Kornati Islands

A surreal maze of limestone islands rising from intensely blue sea. Raw, elemental, and breathtakingly beautiful, the Kornati offer wide-open water and a powerful sense of freedom.

# Telašćica

Sheltered turquoise bays, dramatic cliffs, and a tranquil saltwater lake create a landscape of contrast and calm. The water here is protected and serene — perfect for flowing, confidence-building swims.

# Šibenik

Ancient stone streets, UNESCO-listed architecture, and a proud Dalmatian spirit. Šibenik is both historic and intimate — a fitting finale where celebratory swims meet warm evenings and shared memories of an extraordinary journey.
